GRADING SCALE

The Dutch grading scale is from 1 (very poor) to 10 (outstanding). The lowest passing grade is 6.

A grade of 9 is seldom given and a 10 is extremely rare.

The grades 1 - 3 are hardly ever used.

In some cases no grade is given, only a "pass".

POLICY: RE-SIT / LONG DISTANCE EXAMS

Incoming students

The Boards of Examiners at HAN do not permit students, who have studied at a partner university, to write long distance exams offered by the host university once they have returned to HAN. In certain, exceptional, cases the possibility to write such an exam may be discussed.
