HAN University of Applied Sciences offers one-week summer courses in the fields of health, social studies, sports and education. Join us for 3 weeks of hands-on learning and fun. Each course is worth 2 ECTS credits and includes a field trip.

The courses in this Summer School are open to all undergraduate students from our partner universities. You don't necessarily have to be studying in the field of health, social studies, sports or education to join us. In fact, that is what makes this Summer School so special. The opportunity to step into unknown territory: a truly rewarding experience!

Your classes take place from Monday to Friday, with plenty of room for social activities in the evenings. Weekends are for relaxing or exploring the Netherlands. This way you learn more about the Netherlands and Dutch culture while you're here! For the more adventurous it's easy to extend your travel to other parts of Europe. Think of London, Paris and Berlin. Or Prague, Ljubljana and Warsaw!

- Visit local institutions and organizations.
- Experience our interactive teaching style.
- Attend workshops led by inspiring and experienced lecturers.
- Gain insight into related fields of interest.
- Learn about Dutch culture and society.
- Experience an enjoyable and inspiring combination of study and leisure activities.
- Make new friends from all around the world!

You choose one course per week and we will make sure you have an unforgettable stay in Nijmegen and the Netherlands!

6 ECTS CREDITS

Complete our 3 week Summer School, including preparation and assignments, and earn 6 ECTS credits.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

COSTS

ALL INCLUSIVE FEE: €1850,-

For students from our partner universities.

This fee includes:

- Accommodation at the Zeven Heuvelen Resort in Groesbeek.
- Health and liability insurance for 3 weeks.
- Local transportation to and from HAN on weekdays.
- Field trips and company visits.

ADDITIONAL COSTS

- Travel costs.
- Food and drinks (about €150-€200 per week).
- Personal expenses.

SCHEDULE

The summer school is a full time program and lasts 3 weeks. We start on Monday 16 June and end on Friday 4 July.

ARRIVAL DAY

Arrival Sunday 15 June after 3pm.

CLASSES

You will have classes Monday to Friday from 9am to 5pm, including at least 1 field trip or cultural excursion per week. On weekends you'll be free to explore Nijmegen, the Netherlands and other parts of Europe.

DEPARTURE DAY

Check out on Saturday 5 July before 10am.

ACCOMMODATION

You will stay at the [Zeven Heuvelen Resort](#) in Groesbeek. Groesbeek is a village just outside Nijmegen with a direct bus connection to HAN campus.

Each accommodation has shared bedrooms with separate beds. You share the living room, bathroom and kitchen. The kitchen is fully equipped so you can prepare your own meals.

The accommodation has free WiFi and bed linen is included. You can use the sports and wellness facilities of the resort and use their washer and dryer for a small fee.

Nijmegen is the oldest city of the Netherlands with a city center full of important historical locations.

And it's not just a rich cultural history that Nijmegen has to offer. A large number of students, numerous events and festivals, unique hot spots and cozy restaurants all add up to an unprecedented liveliness in our city.
